#REDWEDNESDAY

'...get up and enter the city, and you will be told what you are to do.'

(Acts 9:4,6)

Perhaps for reason of being offended by what religion generally or Christianity in particular stands for, persecution seems to be at its peak in our time. We recall that Saul persecuted the early Church until he heard the Voice on his way to Damascus that asked him, 'Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me?' As in the days of Saul, so it is in our own time and even worse. As Saul was wrong in his time, so are the 'Sauls' of our time, their reason and vehemence notwithstanding. Now

is the time to listen to what the Lord himself told Saul and tells each of us. '...get up and enter the city, and you will be told what you are to do.' (Acts 9:6).

The Catholic Charity Aid to the Church in Need organising #REDWEDNESDAY with support from Christian Solidarity Worldwide (CSW): they are asking people to wear an item of red clothing on Wednesday November 22 and to share images and their activities on social
