Confirmation 2018

At Sacred Heart parish this year we have assisted hundred young people preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation, requiring two Masses.

75 candidates and their families celebrated their Confirmation on Saturday 30 June.

Another 25 candidates and their families will celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation on Sunday 8 July as part of our usual 5pm Mass. (N.B. Mass will be more crowded than usual and will take approximately 20-30 minutes longer).
