Exploring our Faith

May They All Be One

The words of Jesus in the Gospel today are powerful. They were first spoken to apostles by Jesus during the last supper: 'May they all be one. Father, may they be one in us as you are in me and I am in you so that the world may believe it was you who sent me.' The unique relationship between Jesus and the Father is a relationship that is open to those who believe in the name of Jesus. Those who share in that relationship are bound to one another through love, as he says, 'I have

...that they may be one even as we are one.

John 17:22

made your name known to them and will continue to make it known, so that the love with which you loved me may be in them and so that I may be in them.' The words spoken by Jesus on that special night to the apostles are addressed to us. It is an invitation into a close personal relationship with the very Trinity

itself. At this time of year there are so many feasts coming together which focus on the consequences of Jesus' love for us, from the events of Easter and the Resurrection of Jesus to his Ascension and the outpouring of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, to the celebration of the nature of God himself in the feast of the Trinity. To these holy days we add our first Holy Communions and our Confirmations. This week, on Tuesday, we also have our celebration to wish Fr Ted farewell as he leaves us for Margate.
