Readings: Deut 18:15-20 Ps 94:1-2,6-9 | Cor 7:32-35 Mark 1:21-28

TODAY'S MASS

First Reading: the prophet Moses foretells of a prophet who will be the authoritative voice of God. For Christians, of course, that is Jesus Christ

Today's Psalm warns us not to forget the disobedience of our ancestors (see Exodus 17). 'Meribah' means 'strife', 'dispute', while 'Massah' means 'testing'.

Second Reading: in answer to the Corinthians' suggestion that a disciple of Christ should abstain from all sexual relationships and should not get married, St Paul (amongst other points) says that the important thing, rather, is to give one's "undivided attention to the Lord".



Gospel: the main significance of today's Gospel is Jesus' authority in word and in deed. Jesus taught with authority and confirmed His words with His actions. How can we in the Church be channels for the living, authoritative word of Jesus Christ?
