The Merciful Father - Laetare Sunday

There really is a no more beautiful parable than that of the prodigal son, or as it is often referred to today, 'the parable of the merciful Father'. It is the story we listened to in the gospel reading today. There are so many different lessons to be learned today in the from story, the motivation of the son to claim his inheritance and leave the family home, to his return in shame, seeking not the forgiveness of his father but his tolerance and forbearance. We have the reaction of the



father to the return of his youngest son, and we have the almost predictable reaction of the oldest son to his brother's return. For me the reaction of the Father to his son's return is the most moving. He isn't going about his daily business when his son turns up

and asks to be treated as one of the household servants. No, the Father is there on the road scanning the horizon for any sign of his son's return. He had probably done that day by day since his son left. We can only but imagine the sadness in the Father when day by day there was no sight of his son on the dusty road. He never gave up. His daily vigil was repaid when this day, there in the distance. was the outline of a familiar figure, his long lost son. We can only imagine the joy he felt at this longed for reunion. Jesus is telling us that this is how our Father heavenly responds to us. We should have no fear only love for Him.
