

Prepare Ye The Way Of The Lord:

These words echo through the readings offered to us in the lectionary for this season of Advent. Each time I hear those words I can't help but remember the lively chorus sung the musical

'Godspell' The words are both joyous yet challenging. 'Prepare', infers that something has to be done. Actions have to be taken. 'Prepare the way of the Lord' directs those actions to our selves. We, each one of us, needs to prepare—to get ready for the coming of the Lord. Advent is the perfect time to do that preparation. As we await the celebration of the birth of Our Lord in the stable at Bethlehem we



remember that lesus us most comes especially through sacraments. There is a strong tradition in the church that we make our Christmas Communion completed having Advent preparation. To **Eucharist** receive that should worthily we receive the sacrament of reconciliation before our Christmas Mass. There are many opportunities to confession for to go Christmas. Confessions are heard each day at 6pm

on a Saturday. During the leading week up Christmas we will have two priests available at each time. In addition to regular times Reconciliation there will be Reconciliation parish Service on Thursday 15th December at 8:00pm. We hope to have a number of visiting priests available to help us on that evening. Do take the opportunity to receive the loving merciful forgiveness of God our loving Father. That truly is a great way to 'Prepare the way of the Lord' this Advent. There will also be service special Thursday 22nd December at 8pm. This will be a service of readings and hymns in preparation for Christmas. Put both dates in your diary.
