A Golden Opportunity

This Wednesday is Ash Wednesday when we begin the holy season of Lent. It is our preparation for the coming feast of Easter when we celebrate the Resurrection of lesus from the dead, and the hope of salvation which he offers to all who believe in his name. If we have used Lent to deepen relationship with our God then we will be able to say that we have in a real sense shared in the resurrection of lesus because we will have died to ourselves through our prayer fasting and good works and risen to a new life of grace. During the period of Lent there are a number of additional ways in which we can deepen our prayer life. Each week in Lent there will be a special service to help us focus our thoughts and prayers.



These services will be on a different night each week to the opportunity to give attend at least one of the services to the widest number of people. Each service will reflect a different prayer, from form of charismatic to traditional. The programme of services for the weeks of Lent are available at the back of the church. Do take it home and keep it to hand during the weeks of Lent. Further to these services we will have the Stations of Cross on Wednesday and Friday evenings at 7:15pm following 6:30pm Mass. the The

Stations of the Cross are the traditional devotion for Lent. They help us focus on the final hours in Christ's life. His sacrifice on the cross brings us forgiveness of our sins and opens for us the way to salvation. Each day we have our regular Masses timed to make them accessible to a wide number of parishioners. For those on the way to school or work we have the 7:30am; for those around during the day the 10:00am and for those on the way home the 6:30pm. Also, each day there are confessions at 6:00pm. Those on route to the College or to Donhead have the opportunity to pop into the church and say a quick prayer. The Lord invites us to his house. Accept the invite!
